SIGNS OF A GAS LEAK

(always follow your nose)

Natural gas has a rotten-egg smell: The gas is naturally odorless. A chemical (mercaptan) is added to the gas to smell bad. That way, you can detect leaks.

A gas leak is dangerous:

Make sure all family members know what to do if they smell gas.

- **Do not light matches**
- **Do not turn lights on or off**
- **Do not use the telephone**
- **If possible, notify everyone in the building to leave immediately**
- **Call the gas company, the fire department or public safety from a nearby building**
- **Do not reenter your home until the gas company has told you it's safe to do so**
